IMPORTANT NOTICE:

 - Failure to identify, with specificity, the copyrighted work claimed to be infringed or, if multiple works are covered by a single complaint, failure to provide a representative list of such works.
 - Failure to identify, with specificity, the material that is claimed to be infringing or to be the subject of an infringing activity and that is to be removed or access to which is to be blocked or disabled, and information reasonably sufficient to permit Mediacom to locate the material.
 - Failure to provide a written statement that the complainant has a good faith belief that the use of the disputed material, in the manner complained of, is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law.
 - Failure to include a written statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that the complainant is authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is infringed.

Jurisdiction of Courts:
